

DECLARATION REACH REGULATION (EC) 1907/2006

MYLAR[®], MELINEX[®] FILM AS MANUFACTURED IN EUROPE/US OR CHINA

DuPont Teijin Films is well aware of the legislative developments regarding the regulation of the industrial chemical substances in the European Union and in particular Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 ("REACH").

DuPont Teijin Films is fully committed to work with its customers and suppliers along the entire supply chain to develop workable solutions to the challenges of REACH.

As per Article 3(3) of the REACH Regulation and the ECHA guidance on 'Requirements for the substances in articles' as published in May 2008 Polyester film is classified as an article.

There are no substances intended to be released from the above film under normal or reasonable foreseeable conditions of use from the film as defined by Article 7(1).

As such, there is no need to register articles Mylar[®], Melinex[®] film or to list the intended uses of the substances in the film in a Safety Data Sheet (SDS sheet) within EU countries.

SUBSTANCES OF VERY HIGH CONCERN (SVHC)

The intent of this statement is to clarify how the DuPont Teijin Films products are affected by the REACH 'Candidate List'.

DuPont Teijin Films confirms that the above products do not contain any of the substances listed in the 'Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern for Authorisation' as below, in a concentration above 0.1 % weight by weight (w/w) .
